



PROCEDURES IN SUPPORT TO THE RED CROSS DURING TIMES OF CONFLICT

Home Station - Prior to Deployment:

Funded Travel Orders: to and from conflict area and to include items: billeting, dining, storage of household goods and travel to deployment point.

Administrative Items: ID card, Geneva card, meal card, dog tags, DAS73 (interim secret clearance), other POM actions such as: wills, powers of attorney.

Uniforms/equipment (including protective gear), if available.

Training: chemical, first aid and other appropriate, if available.

Information on area departing to: recommended supply list, culture awareness, type of money used and check cashing capabilities, if available.

Complete pre-deployment physical examination.

Pancorex-DNA.

Immunizations, if available.

Passports/Visas: country clearance, if available.

Military Drivers License, if appropriate.

Central Deployment Point:

Billeting and dining facilities.

All administrative items not taken care of at home station.

Uniforms/equipment (including protective gear) - if not received at home station.

Training: chemical, first aid, and other appropriate - if not received at home station.

Information on area departing to: recommended supply list, culture awareness, type of money used and check cashing capabilities - if not received at home station.

Panorex-DNA - if not received at home station.

Immunizations - if not received at home station.

Passports/Visas: country clearances - if not received at home station.

Extra baggage space - if carrying office material and equipment.

In-Theater Operations:

Complete support, cooperation, and assistance from command.

Billiting and dining facilities.

Communications support and equipment.

Transportation.

Office space/equipment.

Logistical support.

Use of R&R facilities.

Other privileges accorded to civilians of same GS rating.

Recognition.

Redeployment:

Funded return to home station/home of record.

Other Considerations:

Some Red Cross staff may deploy with units immediately on call up. They will need all the same support as listed above, but from a troop deployment point, not necessarily from a central deployment point. In these cases, the Services will provide direct funding.
