MEMORANDUM FOR THE SURGEON GENERAL

SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority for the Armed Forces Health Surveillance Center

1. References.

2. I hereby delegate to you the authority to act on my behalf, and on behalf of the Secretary of the Army, for all of the responsibilities, functions and authorities assigned pursuant to references 1b and 1c, above. You will be the responsible official for the AFHSC. As such, you will ensure that the Executive Agent responsibilities in references 1a and 1b, above, are executed, integrated, and coordinated with the DoD functional proponent. In addition, you will coordinate with the Force Health Protection Council (FHPC), which functions as the advisory Board of Governors for the AFHSC, as required.

3. This authority may not be further delegated.

4. This delegation expires three years from the date of this memorandum, unless earlier cancelled, modified, or withdrawn.
